ORANGE HEIGHTS A FINE TRACT

Orange Heights tract lots are selling rapidly and this is easily accounted for by the particularly slight location of the new subdivision. The tract is bounded by two among the best avenues in the city, Los Robles being on the west and Molino on the east. North and South the tract is situated between Jackson and Mountain streets and some idea of the size of the big proposition may be obtained from the fact that there are nearly 100 lots in the tract.

Mr. George F. Thompson, the owner and salesman of the lots, lives at No. 147 North Marengo avenue, but he also has a branch office on the tract itself.

Just as fast as workmen can do the work the streets are being graded, curbed, guttered and sidewalked and water mains are being laid. In fact, the tract will be brought strictly down to date after the most improved methods and with a school building but a block away and churches handy, it would be difficult to find a more ideal home place.
